The Good News

The past few years have seen a steady increase in weights & size of fish being caught on our waters, with 1lb roach, large perch & chub appearing regulary. 12 year old Tommy Green has caught himself 2 very nice pike & Olly Smith had a 20 pounder. Ian Paulley fished Nutford, catching almost a fish each cast, ending the day with nearly 50lb. Dave Burford of Tisbury Angling won their visiting match with 38lb 12oz, with Matt Bell 2nd 32lb 13oz.



The 1st of BDAC Senior champs (Nutford top 1st field) only 3 fished but were glad they did as it fished well with good roach and dace showing. Tony Beddingfield was 1st with 18lb 5oz; 2nd Brian Hunt 14lb 11oz & 3rd Paul Allen 9lb 8oz.

The 3rd Senior Champs fished today at Nutford (middle 1st field), 6 fished in cold conditions. The fish didn't mind; 1st John Moody 26lb 9oz; 2nd Brian Hunt 17lb 8oz; 3rd Pete Brundish 11lb 11oz; 4th Alex Compiani 7lb; 5th Paul Allen 5lb 12oz; 6th Tony Bedingfield 2lb 15oz.

Mind the 2nd Senior Champs at Pressham Woods was a reminder that when conditions are less favourable the river can be unforgiving. Tony Beddingfield squeezed out a win with 7oz!!!!! The 4 match Evening Series winner was Paul Allen 27lb 9oz; 2nd Peter Brundish 22lb 8oz; 3rd Brian Hunt 21lb 6oz & 4th Tony Bedingfield 20lb 9oz. James had 3lb 8oz but only fished one match. Total weight was 101lb 7oz (98lb between the 4 who fished every match) which was considered very good for these 3-hour matches.

Both Mark Buckingham & Tony Bedingfield have had very decent chunky chub & of course there is the 'Secret Squirrel Club' who unlike Tony, don't like to pose for the camera & like to keep their catches to themselves.
